COVID-19: Latest Resources & Recommendations

NAPA has been accumulating, developing, and distributing information to our members and the industry regarding the coronavirus pandemic. NAPA recommends checking its <u>coronavirus website</u> for the most up-to-date information regarding <u>Health & Safety</u>, <u>Legislation</u>, and <u>Business Impacts</u>.

The most important prevention factors to consider: **good personal and equipment cleaning** and **maintaining at least 6-feet of social distancing**. **Government agencies have been shutting down construction jobs when workers do not abide by such social distancing**.

 Download the Construction Industry's Exposure Prevention, Preparedness, and Response Plan, provided as a Microsoft Word template, which can be tailored to individual companies. Every company should implement a preparedness and response plan. This downloadable plan also includes a training checklist, a toolbox talk, an employee notification form, and a document that identifies that the industry is an "essential" or "critical" infrastructure industry during shelter-in-place orders. Additional suggested practices for preventing the spread of COVID-19 and state DOT COVID-19 Response Plans are also provided on NAPA's coronavirus Health & Safety webpage.

- Information about COVID-19, including its prevention, is changing rapidly. <u>Check NAPA's</u> <u>coronavirus web page often</u>.
- 6-feet of social distancing is paramount on job sites.
- Every company should implement a COVID-19 preparedness and response plan.
- There may be regulatory requirements associated with voluntary use of face coverings.
- NAPA has partnered with other organizations to provide guidance on <u>Respiratory Protection</u> <u>During COVID-19 for Road Construction Workers</u>. The easy-to-understand guidance provides information on what types of face coverings should be used to help limit the spread of COVID-19. Regulatory requirements associated with voluntary use of face coverings are also provided.
